Spring Checklist

MARCH Inspe

$\hfill \square$ Inspect roofing for missing, loose, or damaged shingles and leaks.
☐ Change the air filters in your home.
☐ Clean window and door screens.
☐ Check locks on windows and doors.
\square Make sure stairway treads, risers, and handrails are solid.
APRIL
☐ Inspect wooden decks for signs of rot or decay.
Remove leaves and other debris from gutters and downspouts.
☐ Inspect outdoor play equipment for safety.
$\hfill \square$ Ensure all electrical outlets and appliances are functioning correctly.
☐ Examine fireplaces for cracking or damaged masonry.
MAY
☐ Inspect siding for damage or cracks.
☐ Check window and door seals for leaks.
☐ Service lawn mower.
☐ Clean and repair outdoor lighting.
☐ Survey for mold in all rooms.



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JUNE
 Clean the dryer vent duct. Check fire extinguishers. Inspect driveway and paths for cracks. Clean kitchen exhaust hood. Clean garbage disposal monthly.
JULY
 Clean the garage and dispose of any hazardous waste properly. Inspect fences and gates for damage. Clean bathroom fans. Check home for any pest infestations. Tighten any loose handles and doorknobs.
AUGUST
 Clean deck and patio. Inspect the fireplace for damage or hazards and clean the chimney. Check washing machine hoses for leaks. Inspect the home's foundation for cracks. Swap out old garage door codes for new ones.

SEPTEMBER

☐ Winterize sprinkler systems to prevent freezing and damage.
☐ Inspect and clean outdoor grills for winter storage.
☐ Service and clean the dehumidifier.
☐ Clean and repair garden hoses.
☐ Treat exterior wood surfaces with weather sealant.

☐ Inspect the roof for damage.

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Winter Checklist

DECEMBER
 Check the water heater for leaks. Inspect the home for any air leaks for heat efficiency. Test electricity circuit breakers. Check fire and carbon monoxide detectors. Clean or replace the dryer vent.
JANUARY
 Inspect the home's interior for any signs of leaks or drafts. Check the attic for proper insulation. Clean kitchen appliances. Inspect bathrooms for any leaks or plumbing issues. Make sure gutters are free from any ice dams and icicles.
FEBRUARY
 Check the home's exterior for any damage caused by winter weather. Inspect the basement for any signs of moisture. Check the sump pump to ensure it is working correctly. Clean the home's interior thoroughly.
